About Devon Air Ambulance

Devon Air Ambulance Trust is the charity that raises the funds to keep Devon's two air ambulances flying and our fleet of critical care cars responding.

Accidents and illness happen and, when they do, patients whatever their age, circumstance or location, need specialist treatment fast. The speed with which our air ambulance doctors and paramedics can reach a patient is crucial in helping to achieve a successful outcome. This enables them to identify their time-critical needs and provide specialist life-saving treatments and interventions to slow, halt or even reverse the effects of a life-threatening condition.

About this volunteer role

We currently have 22 charity shops in Barnstaple (Community Hub & Media) Bideford, Budleigh Salterton, Crediton, Dartmouth, Exeter (Cowick St & Heavitree), Exmouth, Honiton, Kingsbridge, Newton Abbot, Okehampton, Paignton, Plymouth, Sidmouth, South Molton, Tavistock, Topsham (x2) Torquay and Totnes. We sell clothes, bric-a-brac, books, DVDs, and other preloved items. We also have an Online and Ebay shop.

Retail volunteers are crucial in helping us create a welcoming, friendly, and accessible shopping experience; a great place for shoppers and donors to visit time and time again, and of course, help to generate vital funds.

What will I be doing?

- Designing eye-catching shop and window displays
- Preparing donations for sale and quality control
- Stock control, rotation, and sorting
- Operating the till and dealing with various methods of payment
- Processing Gift Aid donations
- Maintaining a tidy, clean, and safe shopping/working environment
- Helping with events and projects

When can I volunteer?

This is a flexible role to fit with your lifestyle and around other commitments. Whether you can offer one hour or one day, your time and support are hugely valuable. Our retail operating hours vary but are mostly 9-5pm Monday to Saturday with some shops opening on Sundays and Bank Holidays.
